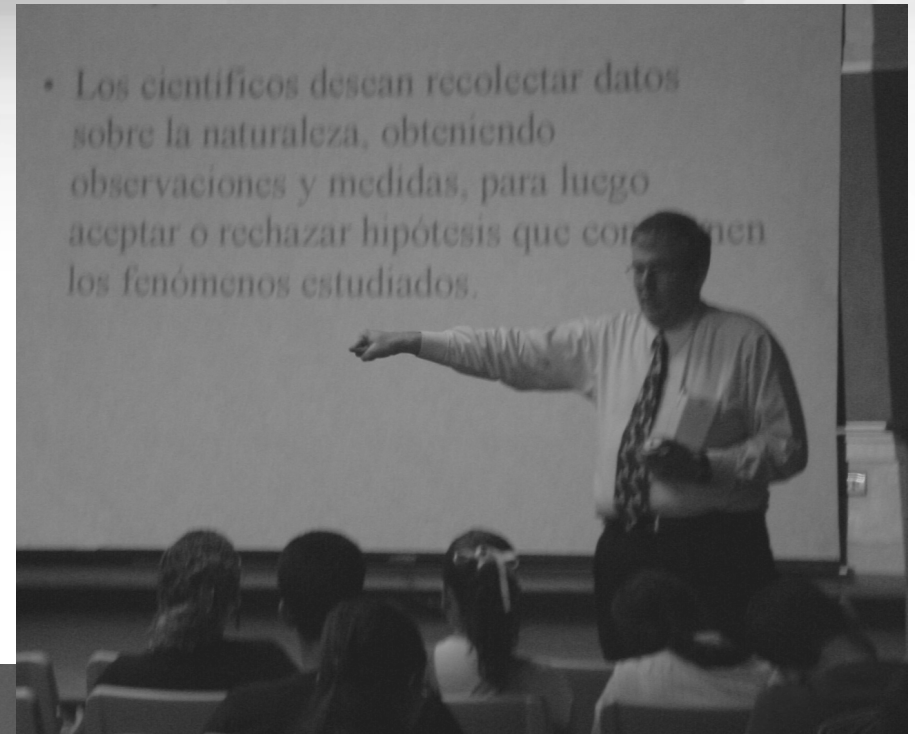

This conference was guided by Pieter Van der Meer. Maher Lugo, a PaSCoR student from Geology, also participated at the conference.



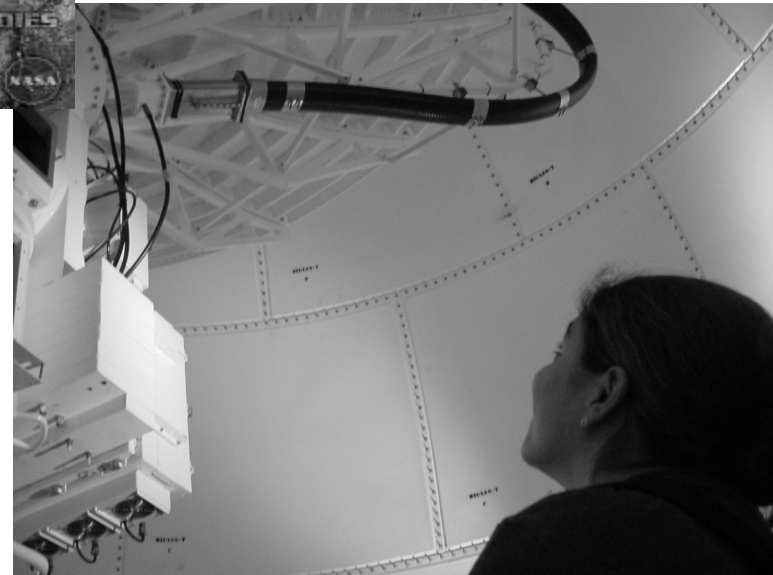

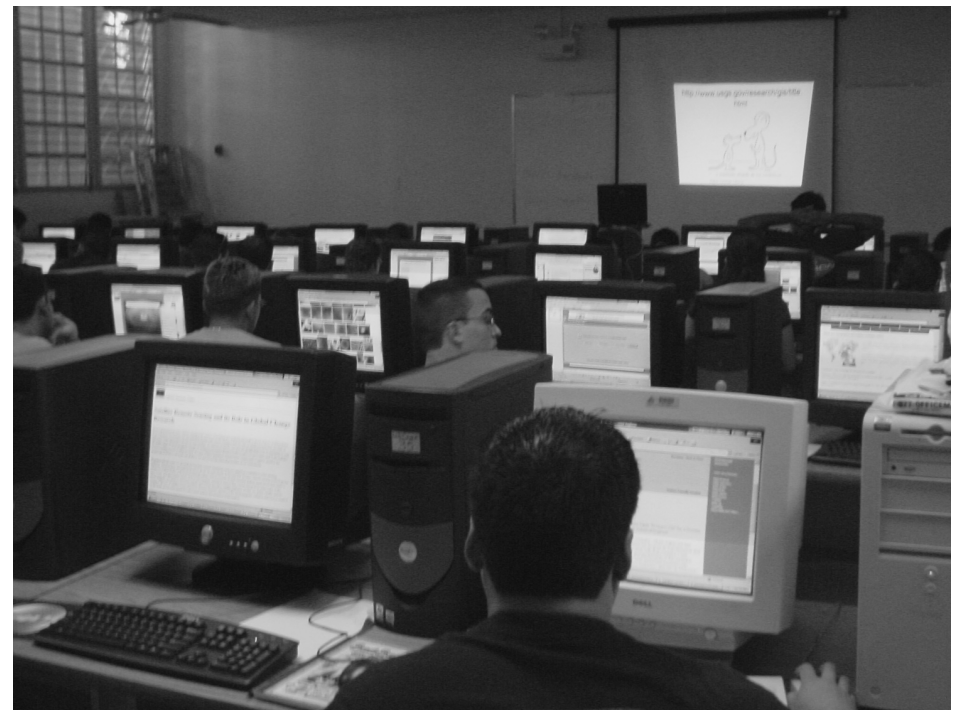


At PaSCoR Laboratory, the students have printers, a scanner, a plotter and the software necessary to work on research.
